

## **FAQ's**

Your dog will be looked at by a veterinarian. He will give your pet a comprehensive exam that not only looks at your pets teeth, but he will look for the general health condition. If you have any questions, even questions about general health, you may ask the vet. His exam is included in the price.

### **How do they clean the dog's teeth?**

Small dogs are swaddled in a blanket. Large dogs lay in the hygienists lap. Teeth are hand-scaled and hand polished.

### **Can they do all dog's?**

Most dogs will accept the cleaning. For the dogs who are too difficult or advanced, they are differed back to their vet for a cleaning with anesthesia. There is no charge for dog's we cannot clean.

### **Can they clean large dogs?**

Yes. There is an additional \$25 charge for dogs over 75 pounds.

### **How long does the cleaning take?**

Typically, it takes approx. ½ hour, sometimes more, depending on the level of tartar. The Doctor will give you a return time when he looks at your dog.

### **Can they clean cats?**

No.
